# GUIDELINES LEGAL WALKS 2021

Thank you for signing up to take part in this year's Legal Walks! With your help we can raise much needed money and awareness for free legal advice services and everyone who needs them at this difficult time.



## Joining Instructions

Please do not attend the event if you feel unwell or have any Covid-19 symptoms. This includes a high temperature, a continuous cough, or a loss of taste or smell.

- This year we will be operating staggered start times to avoid groups of more than 30 people gathering at the registration point. This means there will be no speeches at the start of the Legal Walk this year.
- Please arrive to register with your team and allocate **one** team representative to register and pick up the route map. Once this is complete you will be able to start the walk immediately. **Please ensure that you walk in groups of no more than six.**
- Teams or individuals may choose to walk elsewhere and still count as part of the walk (just let us know).
- It is also possible to join the official walk route at the nearest point to your office and walk round from there rather than joining at the start point (again just let us know)

# Safety Guidelines

## PRE-EVENT

- Please bring a mask or face covering with you on the day. You will not need to wear this on the walk, which takes place outside, but we do ask you to wear a mask at the registration point when you first arrive, and one may also be required at the end venue.

- Bring hand sanitiser so that you are able to sanitise your hands on a regular basis on the walk.

- Remember to bring a bottle of water and sunscreen to protect from warm weather, or a brolly/waterproofs in the event of wet weather.

- Please be respectful of fellow participants, event staff and the public throughout the day and operate social distancing measures at all times.

## POST-EVENT

- When you arrive back at the end of the walk, please be aware of others around you, take a drink and make sure to spread out.

-If the post-event drinks reception takes place indoors, please take

your welcome drink and sit at tables with no more than 6 people. Please also adhere to any additional measures put in place by the venue and be prepared to use your phone to scan the NHS track and trace app.

-If the post-event drinks reception takes place outside, please form a socially-distanced queue to take a welcome drink and then make sure to spread out in the space provided and form groups of no more than six, or two households.
